

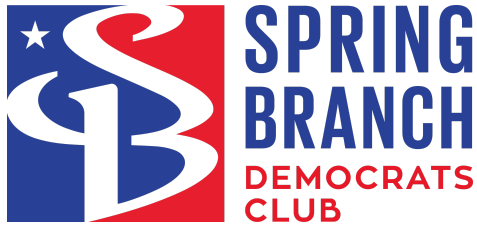

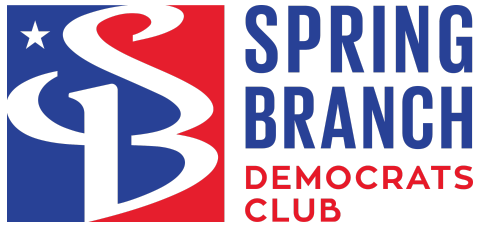

Finance Committee - Chair David Lopez

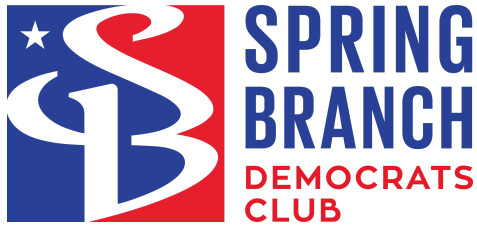
